LIMITED RELEASES & FEATURES

Honey Chamomile Blonde Trip XIII (Colaboration - New Belgium, Elysian, & The Beer Chicks) New Belgium says "When 2 breweries set off to make great beers together, the end journey is the beginning of a very new trip." 13th release in the "trip" series.

Polycot (Hangar 24, Redlands, CA) Poly=Many cot=Apricot. This wheat ale is brewed w/hundreds of pounds of organic apricots grown in Southern Cal's High Desert. The mellow wheat balances perfectly w/natural apricot flavors & aromas to create a fresh, pleasantly tart summertime treat.

Four Calling Birds Strong Dark Ale (The Bruery, Placentia, CA)

Spice, banana bread, molasses, bitter chocolate, dark fruit, & licorice notes.

Hoptober Golden Ale (New Belgium Brewing, Ft. Collins, CO)

Seasonal ale made w/wheat, rye, barley & oats.

Summerfest (Sierra Nevada Brewing, Chico, CA)

Refreshing pilsner style lager. Smooth & light.

Aecht Schlenkerla Rauchbier Marzen (Br. Heller, Bamberg, Germany)

Dark, bottom fermented, brewed w/self-made Original Schlenkerla Smoke malt & tapped according to old tradition directly from gravity-fed oak wood casks.

Deus Brut Des Flanders Belgian Strong Ale(Br. Bosteels, Buggenhout, Belgium)

First brewed at Bosteels, transferred to the Champagne region of France where it is treated much like a champagne w/the bottles inverted & the yeast expunged.

Bush Prestige (Br. Dubuisson, Freres, Leuze Pipaix, Belgium)

Aged in oak barrels for 6 months, then bottle conditioned, then set in a hot temperature room causes re-fermentation in the bottle that gives a cloudiness & high ABV. The old style maturation, in oak barrels, enables the drinker to fine aromas and tannins absent in beers for decades.

LIGHT & CRISP

Sudwerk Helles Lager (Sudwerk Restaurant & Brewery, Davis, CA)

Golden beer reminiscent of Bavaria's Munchener Helles. Malty, artfully balanced, subtle bitter bite.

Citrus, rose/honeysuckle, peach, & ginger notes.

Orange Wheat (Hangar 24 Brewery, Redlands, CA)

Crisp, tangy, refreshing. Whole local oranges used throughout the process.

Bavarian style wheat beer. 50% wheat malt, 50% 2-row malt w/Noble hops imported from Germany.

Their first beer. German style hefeweizen, brewed w/Northern Cal citrus.

American style wheat ale infused w/Maui Gold Pineapple.

Banana, clove, lemon, & sour notes.

Hopf Helle Weisse (Weibierbrauerei Hopf, Germany)
Unfiltered wheat beer with subtle fruit notes. Dry finish.

Schonram Festweise (Br. Schonram, Germany)
Brewed for the first time in 2005, to commemorate 225 years of brewing, this delicious dry wheat seasonal fest beer has notes of banana & clove.

Bruton di Bruton (Birrificio Bruton, Lucca, Italy)
Light, opalescent beer, w/white creamy & persistent froth. Light hopping & delicate spice, fruity Italian wheat beer.

Bruton Bianca Witbier (Birrificio Bruton, Lucca, Italy)
Belgian white characterized by fresh acidity, coriander & orange peel

Texture is almost creamy. Notes of lemon rind, poached spiced pears, papaya, hay, toasted crackers & honey.

Lambics: Framboise (raspberry), Pomme (apple), Peche (peach), (Br. Lindemans, Vlezenbeek, Belgium)
Lambic is a very distinctive type of beer brewed in the Pajottenland region of Belgium (SW of Brussels) & in Brussels. Long before hops were common in most beers, various fruits & vegetables were used to season beers. Magnificent aroma, sparkling, fruity, sweet/tart, clean natural taste.

Delicate balance of fruit & spice, hints of tart & sweet, bouquet of Granny Smith apples.

Effervescent Belgian-style pale ale. Fruit, bread & spice notes.

Brewed w/a rare Belgian yeast strain, which gives a complex spicy flavor & aroma. Noticeable hops & medium malt character. Balanced & crisp.

Full-bodied deep amber Belgian-style, w/notes of apricot, orange peel & spice.

Famous German Weizenbock. Strong, rich, notes of raisin bread.

Rich malt, delicate hop, intense flavor.

Complex, smooth, rich, toasty, peaty smoke, toffee & dark fruit notes.

A combination of lager yeast strains & dark chocolaty malts to redefine what dark beer can be!

“Mild” refers to an English-style beer that is malt-accented yet light bodies & low in alcohol.

Silky mouth feel, toasty, coffee & dark chocolate notes.

Samuel Smith Oatmeal Stout (Samuel Smith Old Brewery, Tadcaster, England) Silky texture, complex, medium-dry velvet palate. Bittersweet finish.

Malty, smooth, dense, notes of coffee, chocolate, & a slightly dry finish.
